

BARANGAY HISTORY

The name Caputican, may sound so ordinary but not its gained reputation. In fact, Barangay Caputican before is the poorest barangay of Talavera in terms of income, because the 118 hectares total area of the barangay is mostly a forest, wherein wild trees and grasses grew on it. According to some, different wild animals lived in this place like wild pigs, deer and monkeys among others. These wild animals ran after each other everytime, which causes “putik” (tagalog for mud) on the streets. From the tagalog word “putik” comes the name Caputican (mud area).

Barangay Caputican is 12 kilometers away from Talavera. It is situated north of the town. The poor barrio is developing so fast because of the people’s industry and positive working habits. Added to this is the systematic planning and implementation of honest barangay officials who worked in the most effective way.
